

ORDINANCE NO. 778

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY ON THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF CHURCH AND LOCUST STREETS TO BE IN THE C-2 GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 27-2 of the Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being in the R-4 Multiple Family Residential District to be in the C-2 General Commercial District, viz:


Lots 3 and 4 and the East 47 feet of Lot 2, Block 2, as shown on map entitled "Town of Mokelumne" (now City of Lodi), recorded August 25, 1869 in Volume 2, page 12, Book of Maps and Plats, Official Records of San Joaquin county.


The alterations, changes and amendments of said official District Map of the City of Lodi herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with the provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.


