

ORDINANCE NO. 812

AMENDING SECTION 27-12(b)1 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY PERMITTING BUILDINGS IN EXCESS OF THIRTY-FIVE FEET IN HEIGHT IN THE "M" INDUSTRIAL ZONE

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of Section 27-12(b) of the Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

1. Building Height Limit: Five stories but not to exceed one hundred(100)feet. Buildings requiring a height in excess of this provision may be erected after first securing a use permit from the City Planning Commission.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage.
