ADOPTING AN OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE
VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF LODI FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1966 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1967


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated and allocated from unexpended and unappropriated balances of funds in the City Treasury and from anticipated income in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1966 and ending June 30, 1967 the following monies for the support of the departments of the City of Lodi during said fiscal year:


