

ORDINANCE NUMBER 87.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR 1916 IN PROVISION OF  
REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1917.

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The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:

Section 1. In the year 1916, and in provision of revenue for Said City of Lodi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1917, upon all the real and personal property within the City of Lodi, taxable for municipal purposes, there is hereby levied taxes as follows, to-wit:

For the general purposes of said city, at the rate of fifty cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property; for public library purposes of said City at the rate of thirteen cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property; and for bond redemption and interest purposes of said City at the rate of thirty-seven cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property. .

The aforesaid tax rate of thirty-seven cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property is the rate for bond redemption and interest on bonds of said City issued and outstanding on the 8th day of November, 1910, having been issued in the year 1908, and is apportioned as follows:

For redemption and interest on sewer bonds fourteen cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For redemption and interest on water and light bonds twenty-three cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation, printed

and published in the said City of Lodi, and shall take effect thirty days after its passage, approval and publication.
