

ORDINANCE NO. 915

ZONING PROPERTY ON THE NORTH SIDE OF  
KETTLEMAN LANE BETWEEN CRESCENT AND  
FAIRMONT AVENUES TO BE IN THE R-MD, ~~MEDIUM~~  
DENSITY MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain **as** follows:

Section 1. The property hereinafter described is hereby zoned and classified **as** being in the R-MD, Medium Density Multiple-Family Residential District, viz:


A 2.7-acre parcel located **on** the north side of West Kettleman Lane, adjacent to the Leroy Nichols School, between South Fairmont Avenue and South Crescent Avenue.


The above zoning herein set forth has **been** approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with the provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar **as** such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published **one** time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in **force** and **take** effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.


