

ORDINANCE NO. 92

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 90 AND AMENDING SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE NUMBER THIRTY-EIGHT AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 89.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF LODI DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance ~~88~~ as amended by Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended, by adding to said Section the following:

And except that on North School Street from Lockeford Street to De Force Avenue the curb line on the West side of said School street shall run straight from a point on the North line of lockeford Street, eighteen (18) feet East of the South East corner of Block "B" of the Gordon Tract as designated on the official map of the City of Lodi to a point on the South line of De Force Avenue twenty-five (25) feet East of the Northeast corner of said. Block "B", and that the curb line on the East side of said portion of North School Street shall be thirty (30) <sup>feet</sup> East from and parallel to the West line above described:

And except, that for the first 110 feet of North School Street North of De Force Avenue, the curb line on the West side of said portion of said Street shall run straight from a point on the North line of De Force Avenue, five (5) feet East of the West line of said portion of North School Street to a point on the produced West line of Block "A", Gordon Tract, fifteen (15) feet East of the West line of said portion of said street; and that the East curb line of the above described 110 feet of North School Street shall be thirty (30) feet East from and parallel to the West curb line immediately above described.

And except that on said North School Street, between Locust and Lockeford Streets and between De Force Avenue, and the city limits on the North (except as <sup>was</sup> herebefore stated), the curb line is hereby fixed and shall be distant from the division lines between said School Street and the blocks or lots abutting respectively thereon, fifteen (15) feet.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 90 is hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published in The Lodi Sentinel, and shall take effect and be in force (from and after thirty days) after its passage and publication.


