

ORDINANCE NO. 948

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 27-9A OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY INCLUDING THEATERS WITH A MAXIMUM SEATING CAPACITY OF 400 IN THE USES PERMITTED SECTION.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 27-9A of the Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

(b) Uses Permitted: Only those uses permitted in the C-1 Neighborhood Commercial District are permitted in this district except that a department store, theaters with a maximum seating capacity of 400, and a cocktail lounge when operated in conjunction with a restaurant and opened only during restaurant hours shall be included as additional permitted uses and that residential uses of any type shall be prohibited.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
