

ORDINANCE NO. 95,

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE TREASURER AS EX-OFFICIO CITY TAX COLLECTOR
PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES, AND APPOINTING THE CITY MARSHAL AS EX-OFFICIO
SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS, PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES AND FIXING HIS BOND
AS SUCH SUPERINTENDENT.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City Treasurer shall be Ex-Officio City Tax Collector of the City of Lodi, and it shall be his duty, instead of the duty of the City Marshal, to collect all taxes levied and assessed by the Board of Trustees, of said City of Lodi,

Section 2. The City Marshal is hereby appointed Ex-Officio Superintendent of Streets of the City of Lodi, and he shall have general supervision of the streets of said city, and perform all other duties prescribed by law for Superintendents of Streets.

Section 3. Before entering upon the duties of his office, said Superintendent of Streets shall give a bond to the said City of Lodi in the penal sum of \$ 1000.00. / 000

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in The Lodi Sentinel, and shall take effect and be in force from and after the 15th day of April, A. D. 1918.


