

ORDINANCE NO. 1405

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
EXTENDING FOR SIX MONTHS, THE MORATORIUM ON THE
CONSTRUCTION OR RECONSTRUCTION OF OFF-PREMISES SIGNS
WITHIN THE CITY OF LODI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 65858 of the State of California Government Code, and after public hearing held pursuant to said section, the City Council of the City of Lodi hereby declares by the adoption of urgency ordinance, a six-month extension of the moratorium established by Ordinance 1387 adopted by the Lodi City Council on August 6, 1986, on the construction or reconstruction of off-premises signs as defined in Lodi Municipal Code Section 17.63.370.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 3. This urgency ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect immediately.
