

ORDINANCE NO. 1448

AN URGENCY UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL  
ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THOSE RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE  
ESTABLISHED IN RESOLUTION 89-02

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi has heretofore adopted by resolution all rates and charges for water service; and

WHEREAS, under Senate Bill 2263, as filed August 29, 1988, Health and Safety Code 05471 was modified to include "water systems" in those municipal functions which are subject to setting of rates and charges by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Those rates and charges for water service in the City of Lodi, heretofore adopted by the City Council in Resolution 89-02 (attached), are incorporated by reference and adopted as if fully set forth herein.


SECTION 2.

The Council finds that based on public health and welfare interests in the water system, this is an urgency measure, adopted by four-fifths (4/5) vote of the City Council, and shall become effective immediately upon passage.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 4. This urgency ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect immediately.
