

ORDINANCE NO. 1455

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL  
REPEALING AND REENACTING LODI MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.04.070  
SPECIFYING PROCEDURES FOR ELECTION OF THE MAYOR AND MAYOR PRO **TEMPORE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Lodi Municipal Code Section 2.04.070 specifying procedures for election of the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Lodi Municipal Code Section 2.04.070 specifying procedures for election of the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore is hereby reenacted as follows :

Section 2.04.070 Presiding officer - Mayor - Mayor Pro Tempore.  
The presiding officer of the Council shall be the mayor who shall be elected by the Council annually at the first regular meeting after the canvass of votes done in conjunction with the statewide general election in even numbered years. In years where there is no general statewide election, the mayor shall be elected at the first regular meeting in November. At the time of the election of the mayor, one of the members of the Council shall be chosen as mayor pro **tempore**. If the mayor is absent or unable to act, the mayor pro **tempore** shall serve until the mayor returns or is able to act. The mayor shall preserve strict order and decorum at all regular and special meetings of the Council. He shall state every question coming before the Council, call for the vote, announce the decision of the Council on all subjects and

decide all questions of order, subject, however, to an appeal to the Council, in which event a majority vote of the Council shall govern, and conclusively determine such question of order. He shall sign all ordinances adopted by the Council during his presence. In the event of the absence of the mayor, the mayor pro tempore shall sign ordinances as then adopted.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
