

ORDINANCE NO. 178.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR 1930 FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1931.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows :

Section 1: Municipal taxes providing revenue for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1931 are hereby levied upon all real and personal property in the City of Lodi assessable as of 12 o'clock Noon of the first Monday in March, 1930 as follows :


For GENERAL FUND at the rate of forty-five cents (45¢) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property ;

For LIBRARY FUND at the rate of twenty-six cents (26¢) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property ;

For BOND INTEREST AND REDEMPTION FUND at the rate of fifty-four cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property, the said rate of fifty-four cents (54¢) including payments for redemption and interest on bonds issued and outstanding on the 8th day of November, 1910 apportioned as follows : For redemption and interest of Sewer Bonds of 1908 at the rate of four and four-tenths cents and for Water and Light Bonds of 1908 at the rate of **six and six-tenths** cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property,

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Sentinel and shall take effect and be in force in the manner and at the time provided by law.
