RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council set a public hearing for the regularly scheduled meeting of November 4, 1998, to consider the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Fiscal Year 1998/99 Program of Projects application.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Lodi's Transit Division is in the process of preparing the Program of Projects for fiscal year 1998/99 to be submitted to the FTA. Part of that process is to hold a public hearing. The Program of Projects for fiscal year 1998/99 likely will contain more FTA funds for the Multimodal Station so that construction can be completed.
