Notice thereof having been published in accordance with law and affidavit of publication being on file in the Office of the City Clerk, Mayor Reid called for the Public Hearing to consider the Lockeford Street Improvement Project, Ham Lane to California Street, Lodi, California.

The matter was introduced by Public Works Director Ronsko who presented diagrams of the subject area.

Mr. Ronsko and Associate Civil Engineer Richard Prima detailed various alternates, talked about City standards, traffic, parking and responded to questions as were posed by the Council.


To Lodi City Council;


