Notice thereof having been published in accordance with law and affidavit of publication being on file in the office of the City Clerk, Mayor Hinchman called for the Public Hearing to consider the proposed appropriations of the Federal Revenue Sharing Funds - 1985-86 Budget. Council was apprised that the proposed appropriations of General Revenue Sharing Funds to be used in Fiscal Year 1985-86 are as follows:

Capital Projects -

City Hall Expansion - \$840,640

TOTAL - \$840,640

The matter was introduced by City Manager Peterson. Assistant City Manager Glenn then gave the staff report concerning the matter and responded to questions as were posed by the Council.

There being no persons in the audience wishing to speak on the matter Mayor Hinchman closed the Public Hearing.



RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council conduct the required public hearing associated with the recommended appropriations of Federal Revenue Sharing funds as presented in the 1985-86 budget, and take action as deemed appropriate.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Federal Revenue Sharing regulations provide that public agencies hold a public hearing prior to the allocation of annual Federal Revenue Sharing monies. The 1985-86 budget document presents the recommended allocation for the coming fiscal year on page 62. The purpose of this hearing is to provide the opportunity for public input regarding the ultimate disposition of these funds.
