

SUBJECT: Public Hearings for Required Installation of Sidewalks

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This public hearing is to hear objections from property owners who are being required to install sidewalk.

Notices to Construct were sent to two property owners on Stockton Street and two property owners on Lockeford Street. The Notices require that they commence construction of the sidewalk fronting their property within 60 days. The State of California Streets and Highway Code requires that the legislative body hear and pass upon objections at a hearing which shall be set no sooner than ten (10) days after giving notice.

One of the property owners on Stockton Street who received a notice has already started to install the sidewalk. The others have indicated that they are in the process of securing estimates for the work. This procedure is set forth in the State of California Streets and Highway Code.
