

SUBJECT: Setting Public Hearing for Proposed One-Way
Street System in Cannery Area

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council set a Public Hearing for the first meeting in July for the purpose of reviewing a proposed one-way street system in the cannery area.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: During the cannery season, the intensity of parking and the narrowness of streets in the cannery area causes a traffic-flow problem. The Public Works Department has recently reviewed the need for one-way streets in the cannery area and are recommending that a Public Hearing be set for a one-way street system.

Attached is a letter dated June 6, 1985, which transmits a proposed one-way street system for this area and asks for input and comments from emergency services and other affected parties. 
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:


