

RESOLUTION NO. 97-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF FORTY-TWO
PADMOUNT TRANSFORMERS

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on July 22, 1997 at 11:00 a.m. for the purchase of forty-two padmount transformers for the Electric Utility Department, described in the specifications therefore approved by the City Council on June 18, 1997; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that award of the bid for the purchase of forty-two padmount transformers for the Electric Utility Department, be made to the bidders whose proposals and equipment met City of Lodi specifications, and whose transformers yielded the lowest overall life-cycle costs in each rating category, to wit:
