

RESOLUTION NO. 96-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT DAY ROOM FURNITURE,
APPROVING REVISED BID SPECIFICATIONS AND AUTHORIZING READVERTISEMENT

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council sealed bids were received and publicly opened on February 21, 1996 at 11:00 a.m. for the bid for Fire Department Day Room Furniture, described in the specifications therefore approved by the City Council on February 7, 1996 and
