A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
CERTIFYING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION AS ADEQUATE ENVIRONMENTAL
DOCUMENTATION FOR THE LODI CENTRAL CITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM
