

RESOLUTION NO. 96-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL  
 AWARDING THE BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF CENTRAL CITY  
 REVITALIZATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, SCHOOL STREET AND  
 CHEROKEE LANE STREET TREES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council sealed bids were received and publicly opened on June 12, 1996 at 11:00 a.m. for Central City Revitalization Improvement Project, School Street and Cherokee Lane Street Trees, described in the specifications, therefore approved by the City Council on April 17, 1996; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto; and:

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends award of the bid for the Central City Revitalization Improvement Project, School Street and Cherokee Lane Street Trees to the following bidders:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lodi City Council that the award of the bid for the purchase of the Central City Revitalization Improvement Project, School Street and Cherokee Lane Street Trees, be and the same is hereby awarded to Boething Treeland Farms, Inc. of Portola Valley, CA in the amount of \$34,270.00 for 115 London Plane Trees, and Valley Crest Tree Company, of Sunol, California in the amount of \$23,275.20 for 240 Valley Oak Trees; and
