A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE A PUBLIC BENEFITS
CHARGE (PBC) GRANT TO BANK OF LODI DEMAND-SIDE
MANAGEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the State has mandated that beginning January 1, 1998, the City of Lodi is obligated to fund various programs through a Public Benefits Charge (PBC) based on a historical electric revenue requirement; and

WHEREAS, the requirement amount to approximately \$1 Million per year that must be dedicated to qualifying programs such as energy efficiency. A further stipulation is that these efforts must be done on the customer's side of the meter in order to qualify; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Utility Department recommends that the City provide a PBC grant of up to \$75,000.00 to fund a Demand-Side Management Project for the Bank of Lodi, and include the cost of the grant as part of the City's required PBC outlay.


