WHEREAS, funds have been allocated and are available from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for grants to solid waste Local Enforcement Agencies (LEA) and cities and counties with regulatory authority within the city and county government to perform enforcement/compliance and/or surveillance activities at waste tire facilities; and

WHEREAS, the applicant demonstrates it has sufficient staff resources, technical expertise, and/or experience with similar projects to carry out the proposed program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the submittal of an application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a Waste Tire Enforcement Grant; and


