A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL APPROVING
FEE INCREASES AND ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW FEES
RELATING TO ALARM SYSTEMS & PERMITS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 1669 the Lodi Municipal Code requires the City Council, by Resolution, to set fees for various services provided by the City of Lodi to recover those costs associated with providing specific services and programs; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends increasing and establishing fees for Alarm Systems & Permits as shown on the attached schedule marked Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby implement the fee schedule as attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be published one time in the Lodi News Sentinel, a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in full force and effect on the adoption date of Ordinance No. 1669.

“False Alarm” means the activation of an Alarm System through mechanical failure, accident, misoperation, malfunction, misuse or the negligence of either the owner or lessee of the Alarm System or any of their employees or agents. False Alarms shall not include alarms caused by acts of God, the malfunction of telephone lines, circuits or other causes which are beyond control of the owner or lessee of the Alarm System.
