

RESOLUTION NO. 94-37

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A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE DIAL-A-RIDE
OFFICE RENOVATION, 303 WEST ELM STREET

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WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on April 6, 1994 at 11:00 a.m. to renovate the old Hoegerman Photography Studio located on City property at 303 West Elm Street, as described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council on March 16, 1994; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that award of the contract for Dial-A-Ride Office Renovation, 303 West Elm Street be made to the low bidder, Bay Valley Construction of Livermore, California; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lodi City Council that award of contract for Dial-A-Ride Office Renovation be and the same is hereby awarded to Bay Valley Construction of Livermore, the low bidder, in the amount of \$22,270.00.
