

RESOLUTION NO. 94-72

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A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR CIVIC CENTER IMPROVEMENTS,
CITY HALL ANNEX RENOVATION, CARNEGIE BASEMENT RENOVATION,
PORTABLE TRAILERS

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WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on May 26, 1994 at 11:00 a.m. for the bid for Civic Center Improvements, City Hall Annex Renovation, Carnegie Basement Renovation, Portable Trailers, described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council on April 20, 1994; and
