

RESOLUTION NO. 99-193

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE PURCHASE OF SERIAL NUMBER RESTORATION
EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Lodi Municipal Code, §3.20.070, authorizes dispensing with bids for purchases of supplies, services or equipment when it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, in July 1999, the Department of Justice, Bureau of Forensic Services, announced that effective July 2000, they would no longer provide laboratory processing of firearms for the purposes of restoring serial numbers that had been altered or ground off; and

WHEREAS, the new legislation does require the Department of Justice to provide training in the process to local agencies; and

WHEREAS, one Lodi Police Detective completed the training in October 1999, and another will be trained in February 2000; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the equipment needed for this process is approximately \$500.00 with minimal cost for replacement of chemicals; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends purchasing the equipment for the Serial Number Restoration Program.


