

RESOLUTION NO. 93-50

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A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF
EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT FOR THREE POLICE PATROL SEDANS

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WHEREAS, Lodi Municipal Code, Section 3.20.070, authorizes dispensing with bids for purchases of supplies, services or equipment when it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, the Lodi City Council on April 21, 1993 approved the purchase of three 1993 Ford Crown Victoria four-door police patrol sedans for the Lodi Police Department; and

WHEREAS, safety and emergency equipment is required to equip each vehicle for service, consisting of back seats, protective screens, shotgun racks, radio racks, push bumpers, sirens, lights, etc., at a cost of \$4,193 per vehicle, or a total amount of \$12,580 for three vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council hereby approves the award for purchase and installation of said emergency and safety equipment to River City Installation Specialists, Sacramento, and further approves the allocation of \$12,580 to cover the costs of such purchase and installation.
