

RESOLUTION NO. 88-26

AWARD - CONTRACT FOR INSTALLATION/UPGRADE OF KILLELEA SUBSTATION FENCE

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened by the City Clerk of this City on February 16, 1988 at 11:00 a.m. for the contract for installation/upgrade of Killelea Substation Fence, described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council January 20, 1988; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:


