

RESOLUTION NO. 86-84

RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL  
ESTABLISHING "NO PARKING" ON LODI AVENUE  
BETWEEN PLEASANT AVENUE AND THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby approve the installation of raised median bumpers and establishes the following "No Parking zones on Lodi Avenue between Pleasant Avenue and the Southern Pacific Railroad":

CHURCH STREET

1. Install a 120-foot raised median at the eastbound approach.
2. Extend "No Parking" zone 20 feet west of (W/) existing "No Parking" zone on the north side between Pleasant Avenue and Church Street.

SCHOOL STREET

1. Install a 100-foot raised median at the westbound approach.
2. Establish the following "No Parking" zones:
  - a. On the north side, from 100 feet W/School to School.
  - b. On the south side from 110 feet W/School to School.
  - c. On the north side, from School to 140 feet E/School.
  - d. On the south side, from School to Sacramento Street (280 feet).

SACRAMENTO STREET

1. Establish a "No Parking" zone on the north side from 110 feet W/Sacramento to Sacramento.


