

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-163

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING
THE CONTRACT FOR TESTING AND INSPECTION
SERVICES FOR LODI STATION PARKING STRUCTURE
AND LOWER SACRAMENTO ROAD WIDENING
PROJECTS

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WHEREAS, current Building Code requires testing of construction materials and inspection of structural construction methods by qualified independent testing and inspection firms; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal was sent to five interested parties for the Lodi Station Parking Structure Project; and

WHEREAS, Krazan & Associates is the qualified firm with the lowest proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Proposal is worded such that the City can elect to authorize the successful proposer to perform required work on other City projects at the same rates quoted in the Proposal, and staff recommends including with this contract, materials testing for the Lower Sacramento Road Widening Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby award the contract for testing and inspection services for the above projects to Krazan & Associates, Inc., of Sacramento, in the amount of \$89,915.00; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$90,000.00 be appropriated from the Federal Transit Administration funds for this purpose.
