A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING SPECIAL ALLOCATION FOR PURCHASE
OF ADDITIONAL POWER TO MEET CUSTOMER NEEDS

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi purchases bulk power from the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) and the Western Area Power Administration (Western) for resale to the City's electric utility customers; and

WHEREAS, during Fiscal Year 1999-2000, the City purchased additional power in order to meet increased customer needs, as the customer energy requirements grew at a rate of 8.7%, over double the percentage growth of the previous fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends approval of a Special Allocation in the amount of \$1,671,088 for purchase of additional power to meet customer needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council hereby approves a Special Allocation in the amount of \$1,671,088 for purchase of additional power to meet customer needs.
