A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO SUBMIT A FEASIBILITY STUDY GRANT APPLICATION TO
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR GRANT
FUNDING FOR GROUNDWATER RECHARGE FACILITIES

WHEREAS, staff recommends submitting a Feasibility Study Grant application to the California Department of Water Resources to obtain grant funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Groundwater Recharge Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this proposed feasibility study is to evaluate the alternatives presented in the City of Lodi Wastewater Master Plan for effluent treatment and disposal and determine if percolation basins are an economically viable and environmentally beneficial alternative to continued surface discharge; and

WHEREAS, the study will identify the overall impacts of percolation disposal on groundwater storage in accordance with the objectives of the San Joaquin County Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the study will also evaluate the groundwater quality in the area of the proposed percolation facilities; determine mitigation measures to alleviate potential impacts to groundwater quality; and establish a long-term monitoring program for the management of the proposed facilities in accordance with requirements to be established by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to submit a Feasibility Study Grant application to the California Department of Water Resources for grant funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Groundwater Recharge Facilities.
