A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE

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WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council sealed bids were received and publicly opened on May 23, 2001 at 11:00 a.m. for Traffic Safety Improvements, described in the specifications therefore approved by the City Council on July 19, 2000; and
