

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-218

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING
THE BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF 20,000 FEET OF 750kcmil
15kV PRIMARY UNDERGROUND CONDUCTOR

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on September 5, 2001, at 11:00 a.m. for the purchase of 20,000 feet of 750kcmil 15kV XLPE primary underground conductor, described in the specifications, therefore approved by the City Council on August 15, 2001; and
