ANNUAL DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES (DBE)  
GOAL OF 7% FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2001/02

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi is required to develop and submit an Overall Annual Goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) participation for DOT-assisted contracts, as a condition of federal financial assistance, pursuant to Title 49 CFR Part 26; *Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) Programs*; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with DBE regulations, the City of Lodi has developed a narrowly tailored Established Overall Annual DBE Goal of 7% for Federal Fiscal Year 2001/02; and

WHEREAS, City Council adoption is required to ensure compliance with Department of Transportation federal funding requirements, provisions, and financial responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the approval and adoption of the Established Overall Annual Disadvantaged Business Enterprises Goal of 7% for Federal Fiscal Year 2001/02, and, submission to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), on behalf of the City, for final approval.
