

RESOLUTION NO. 81-86

RESOLUTION URGING ALLOCATION OF C.V.P. POWER  
TO THE CITY OF LODI

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi is served by its own municipal electric utility, which was founded in the year 1910;

WHEREAS, this utility currently provides electricity for a population in excess of 35,000;

WHEREAS, electric utility customers have experienced continual energy price increases as a result of escalating fuel costs;

WHEREAS, for more than 20 years the City has been seriously interested in C.V.P. Power as a source of lower-cost energy for its citizens;

WHEREAS, contractual obligations and the absence of C.V.P. allocated capacity have combined to restrict the City's ability to secure an allocation to date;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi, representing all the citizens of this City, emphatically urge the Western Area Power Administration to allocate an equitable quantity of C.V.P. power and energy to the City of Lodi.
