

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL REJECTING
THE APPARENT LOW BID AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT
FOR POWER UTILITY DUCT TO THE NEXT LOW BIDDER,
AND FURTHER AWARDING THE BID FOR CONDUIT
FITTINGS TO THE LOW BIDDER IN THAT CATEGORY

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on March 20, 2002, at 11:00 a.m. for power utility duct, described in the specifications, therefore approved by the City Council on March 6, 2002; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by G. E. Supply Company, the apparent low bidder, contained an "all or none" qualifier, and is therefore considered non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, staff therefore recommends rejecting the bid from G. E. Supply Company and awarding the bid for power utility duct to the next lowest bidder, Azco Corporation, of Stockton, California; and

WHEREAS, staff further recommends awarding the bid for conduit fittings to the low bidder in that category, All-Phase Electric, of Stockton, California.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lodi City Council that the bid from G. E. Supply Company is hereby rejected, and the bid for power utility duct is hereby awarded to the next lowest bidder, Azco Corporation, of Stockton, California, in the amount of \$23,308.72; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council hereby awards the bid for conduit fittings to the low bidder in that category, All-Phase Electric, of Stockton, California, in the amount of \$8,124.83.
