WHEREAS, the POW/MIA flag has been nationally recognized; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi as follows:

1. That all cities are urged to follow the example of the City of Lodi and fly the nationally recognized POW/MIA flag at all facilities owned by the City on Armed Forces, Memorial, and Veteran's Days.
