

RESOLUTION NO. 97-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
EXPRESSING ITS SUPPORT FOR AB1296 DEFINING
SKATEBOARDING AS A HAZARDOUS RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY

WHEREAS, § 831.7 of the California Government Code defines certain recreational activities as hazardous recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, said section provides that neither public entities nor public employees are liable to any person who participates or engages in a hazardous recreational activity on publicly owned property; and

WHEREAS, skateboarding creates a substantial risk of injury to a person who participates in such activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council hereby expresses its support for AB1296 introduced in the 1997-98 regular session of the California Legislature, which adds skateboarding to California Government Code §831.7, thereby defining skateboarding as a hazardous recreational activity.
