

RESOLUTION NO. 97-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE
BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF UNDERGROUND PRIMARY
ELECTRICAL CONDUCTOR

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council sealed bids were received and publicly opened on May 28, 1997 at 11:00 a.m. for the purchase of 20,000 Feet/#2AWG and 20,000 Feet/#2/0 Primary Underground Conductor, described in the specifications therefore approved by the City Council on May 7, 1997; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

20,000 Feet/#2/0 Primary Underground Conductor to Platt Electric of Stockton, CA in the amount of \$23,292.37
