

RESOLUTION NO. 97-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTERIZED  
IRRIGATION SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, Lodi Municipal Code, §3.20.070, authorizes dispensing with bids for purchases of supplies, services or equipment when it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, In October 1996, a presentation of the Rainbird Maxicom Computerized Irrigation System was made to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized staff to move forward in implementing this system in the parks; and

WHEREAS, Maxicom Irrigation Components have been purchased and installed at Peterson Park, which includes a weather station, and Legion Park; and

WHEREAS, Van Buskirk Park, Lodi Lake Park (north and south sides) and five other park sites will be added in the fiscal year 1997/98; and

WHEREAS, the software is the last component needed to begin using the system; and

WHEREAS, it is staff recommendation that the City purchase the Rainbird Maxicom computerized irrigation software for the park system.


