

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-188

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL REJECTING ALL  
BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE LODI UNIFIED SCHOOL  
DISTRICT COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS FUELING STATION

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WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on September 24, 2003, at 11:00 a.m. for the Construction of the Lodi Unified School District Compressed Natural Gas Fueling Station, described in the specifications therefore approved by the City Council on August 20, 2003; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council hereby rejects all bids for the Construction of the Lodi Unified School District Compressed Natural Gas Fueling Station.
