

RESOLUTION NO. 3651

WITHDRAWING CERTAIN PROPERTY ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF
LODI FROM THE WOODBRIDGE RURAL COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION
DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City Council did by Resolution No. 3630 effective May 24, 1972, approve the annexation of that certain real property, contiguous to the City of Lodi designated as "Almond Drive Addition"; and,

WHEREAS, there is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lodi the Certificate of the Secretary of State of the State of California, executed by said Secretary of State on May 30, 1972, referring to said Resolution No. 3630, and the annexation of the real property described therein; and,

WHEREAS, the affidavit of the City Clerk of the City of Lodi certifying to the annexation of said "Almond Drive Addition" in accordance with law was filed with the County Recorder of San Joaquin County on June 8, 1972; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this City Council that that portion of said Property designated as "Almond Drive Addition" which lies within the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District be withdrawn from said District; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Lodi as follows:

That said territory, the annexation of which is described as follows:

A portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 3 of "A. J. Larson's Subdivision" of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, filed for record November 7, 1890 in Volume 2, page 4, Maps and Plats, San Joaquin County Records, said northwest corner being on the existing City Limit line of the City of Lodi; thence leaving said City Limit line South $00^{\circ} 38'$ East, along the west line of Lot 3 and the west line and its southerly extension of Lot 4 of said Subdivision, a distance of 917.05 feet, to a point in the south line of Almond Drive (50 feet wide); thence North $86^{\circ} 44'$ East, along said south line and the easterly extension of said south line, a distance of 1105.20 feet, to a point in the east line of Cherokee Lane; thence northerly along said east line, 50.05 to intersection with the easterly extension of the north line of said Almond Drive, said intersection being on aforesaid City Limit line; thence south $36^{\circ} 44'$ West along said easterly extension and north line of Almond Drive; being along said City Limit line, 732.60 feet to the southwest corner of the "Nathan Addition", as annexed to the City of Lodi, October 5, 1961 by Ordinance No. 704, thence North $0^{\circ} 39'$ West, along the west line of said "Nathan Addition" 868.3 feet, to a point in the north line of aforesaid Lot 3, said point also being the northwest corner of said "Nathan Addition"; thence westerly along said north line of Lot 3, being along said City Limit line, a distance of 372.40 feet, to the point of beginning, and containing 8.67 acres, more or less.

annexed to the City of Lodi by Council Resolution No. 3630, be and it is hereby declared to be withdrawn from the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District.
