

RESOLUTION NO. 3675

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE
NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF VINE STREET

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lodi has determined that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of a "No Parking" zone on the north and south sides of Vine Street at the Stockton Street intersection:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lodi that there is hereby established a "No Parking" zone on the north side of Vine Street from 35 feet east of the centerline of Stockton Street to 95 feet east of said centerline and on the south side of Vine Street from 35 feet east of the centerline of Stockton Street to 140 feet east of said centerline as shown on the sketch attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.


