

STREET LIGHT MAINTENANCE MAN

DEFINITION

Under general direction, to repair, maintain and install city street lights including series and multiple street lighting systems; and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Repairs and maintains street light systems including wiring, ballasts, photo controls, series and multiple relays and conductors and cables; patrols City to repair or replace damaged globes, bulbs, wiring, circuits and switches; installs and maintains standards; installs wires between poles and underground in conduit; paints standards, washes globes and trims trees; may be required to read, set, remove, connect and disconnect meters, install voltage and load survey instruments and service drops; may assist linemen where climbing or contact with high voltage energized equipment is not required.

LICENSE

Possession of an appropriate California operator's license issued by the State Department of Motor Vehicles.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Equipment, tools, instruments and methods employed in the construction and maintenance of street lighting, electrical distribution and transmission systems;

Electrical codes, including State General Orders;

Precautions necessary in working with energized lines and equipment;

Fundamental safe working methods and procedures, first aid and methods of applying resuscitation;

Basic electrical theory as applied to electrical circuits and wiring systems.

and

Street Light Maintenance Man - 2

Ability to:

Safely operate trucks, aerial lifts and other construction equipment;

Understand and carry out oral and written instructions;

Perform minor repairs on trucks and other construction equipment;

Keep simple operating records as required;

Cooperate and work with others to promote and maintain good public relations.

and

Experience:

A minimum of two years' experience in electrical utility construction and maintenance work.

and

Education:

Equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade.
