WEST SIDE OF HAM LANE AT LOCUST STREET

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi that there is hereby established a mail deposit zone on the west side of Ham Lane from the north line of Locust Street to 48 feet north of the north line of Locust Street as shown on the sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.


