

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF LODI AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF PETITION  
FOR ANNEXATION OF NON-CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY  
OWNED BY THE CITY OF LODI TO THE CITY OF LODI

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi is the owner of the hereinafter described real property situated in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; and

WHEREAS, said territory does not exceed one hundred acres in area, to-wit: 99.8 acres; and

WHEREAS, there are no registered voters residing in said territory; and

WHEREAS, the annexation of said territory to the City of Lodi is in the best interests of the City of Lodi; and

WHEREAS, the proposal for annexation of said territory has been submitted and approved upon by the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Joaquin County, said action having been taken by said commission on December 21, 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi, as follows:

1. That the City Council of the City of Lodi requests that the hereinafter described real property be annexed to the City of Lodi, and that Richard L. Hughes, Mayor of the City of Lodi, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute, verify and file the verified Petition for annexation of said territory to the City of Lodi with the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Joaquin, State of California, pursuant

Section 35203 of the Government Code of the State of California.

2. Said territory and real property is situated in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A portion of the Southeast Quarter of Section 23 and the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 5 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of said Section 24, distant along said line North  $89^{\circ} 22' 52''$  West, 3407.31 feet from the Southeast corner of said Section 24; thence North  $19^{\circ} 12' 32''$  West, along the West line of that portion of land conveyed to the State of California by deed recorded May 15, 1968, in Volume 3209, Official Records, page 268, San Joaquin County Records, 144.92 feet; thence North  $20^{\circ} 32' 50''$  West, 1227.33 feet; thence North  $20^{\circ} 46' 50''$  West, West, 800.00 feet; thence North  $22^{\circ} 41' 16''$  West, 595.94 feet; thence North  $89^{\circ} 28' 22''$  West, 1160.97 feet; thence South  $0^{\circ} 57' 15''$  West, 2571.23 feet to a point on the South line of said Southeast Quarter; thence South  $89^{\circ} 22' 52''$  East, along the South line of said Southeast Quarter and the South line of said Southwest Quarter, 2196.00 feet to the true point of beginning.





The undersigned Petitioner, City of Lodi, a municipal corporation of the County of San Joaquin, State of California, respectfully requests and files this Petition with you for the annexation to the City of Lodi of certain real property owned by the City of Lodi. Petitioner represents that said real property is situated in the County of San Joaquin, is non-contiguous to the City of Lodi, contains less than 100 acres, to-wit, approximately 99.8 acres, has no registered voters residing therein or thereon, and is used for municipal purposes, to-wit, sewage disposal plant and facilities.

Petitioner further represents that the proposal for the annexation of said territory hereinafter described was submitted to and approved by The Local Agency Formation Commission of San Joaquin County, California on December 21, 1973.

Petitioner therefore requests that said real property be annexed to the City of Lodi and that the Honorable Board of Supervisors of San Joaquin County, California, annex said territory to the City of Lodi pursuant to Section 35200, et seq., of the Government Code of the State of California.

This Petition is made pursuant to Resolution No.3866 duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Lodi this 16th day of January, 1974.


