

RESOLUTION NO. 4297

ESTABLISHING SPECIAL PARKING AREAS FOR
TWO-WHEELED VEHICLES ON PACIFIC AVENUE
IN THE VICINITY OF LODI HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of special parking zones for two-wheeled vehicles on the west side of Pacific Avenue near Lodi High School;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lodi that there is hereby established special parking zones for two-wheeled vehicles on portions of the west side of Pacific Avenue, said zones to be approximately 320 feet north of the centerline of Oak Street and 330 feet south of said centerline as shown on the sketch attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.




