

RESOLUTION NO. 4441

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC LANES ON  
HIGHWAY 99 OVER THE MOKELUMNE RIVER BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, because of the heavy daily traffic and insufficiency of lanes to handle the volume of traffic on Highway 99, at the Mokelumne River Bridge adjacent to the Turner Road Interchange, a high rate of accidents have occurred in the area: and

WHEREAS, following a study of the area it has been determined that the construction of additional lanes would remedy the existing hazardous condition:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi urges the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to allocate necessary highway funds for the construction of additional lanes on Highway 99 at the Mokelumne River Bridge adjacent to the Turner Road interchange:

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER that copies of this resolution be forwarded to Adreana Geanturco, Director of the California Department of Transportation, Senator John Garamendi, Assemblyman Norman Waters, District 10 of the California Department of Transportation and the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce.
